

1 Corinthians 12:7-11

Spiritual Gifts Part 4

- Healing - ἰαμάτων (2386): a means of healing, remedy, medicine. This is where the Greeks got their word for medicine.
 - Any type of physical, mental or emotional healing is that...a healing...not a miracle. Healings are amazing and awesome. Even anything healed with medicine would still be recognized as a gift of healing.

- Miracles – δυνάμειν (1411): strength, ability, power; inherent power, power residing in a thing by virtue of its nature, or which a person or thing exerts and puts forth. A mighty work.
 - Moral Power; Financial Influence Power; Strength Power; Army Power
 - Webster Dictionary - an extremely outstanding or unusual event, thing, or accomplishment.
 - 1 Corinthians 2:4-5 (CSB) (Power): *⁴My speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of wisdom but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power, ⁵so that your faith might not be based on human wisdom but on God's power.*
 - Philippians 3:10 (CSB) (Power): *My goal is to know him and the power of his resurrection and the fellowship of his sufferings, being conformed to his death...*

- Prophecy – προφητεία (4394): declaring the purposes of God. Connecting to OT prophets, teaching and the gospel.
 - Revelation 19:10 (CSB): *Then I fell at his feet to worship him, but he said to me, "Don't do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers and sisters who hold firmly to the testimony of Jesus. Worship God, because the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."*
 - 1 Corinthians 14:3 (CSB): *On the other hand, the person who prophesies speaks to people for their strengthening, encouragement, and consolation.*

- Tongues - γλωσσῶν (1100): a literal tongue. The language used by a particular people in distinction from that of other nations.
 - Acts 4:11 (CSB): *Cretans and Arabs—we hear them declaring the magnificent acts of God in our own tongues.*

- Interpretation of – ἑρμηνεία (2058): interpret.
 - Tongues - γλωσσῶν (1100): the language used by a particular people in distinction from that of other nations.
